

*Each dau's lesson & activity is designed to take 15 minutes.

1. Project the teaching PowerPoint. Introduce the weekly grammar skill. Read the lesson slides with students. 2. Follow the minilesson with whole group practice. For the practice slides, read each sentence and have students determine where the commas should be placed. Students then slide the commas in place. If you are using a smartboard, you can have students write the commas in. You may want to use one practice slide the first day and the other on another day to reinforce the skill.

3. Students work with a partner for the partner practice slide. Students use a journal, scrap paper, or whiteboards for the writing portion of the slide.

1. Review the minilesson slides if needed. Project the Talk About It slide for students to review further.

Practice worksheet 2. Students complete the practice worksheet.

Task Card Center

Students continue practice using task cards. Use the cards as a literacy center or place them around the room for students to "roam the room" to complete with a partner. Another option is to spread the cards onto desks. Students complete the card and pass it on to the next student. Students can complete the cards in any order.

Thursdau

Students apply the weekly grammar skill to their writing. Choose the option you wish students to use.




Task card game for students to practice independently at a grammar center


