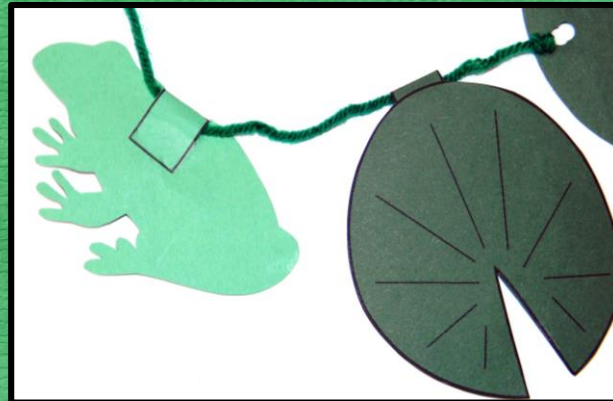
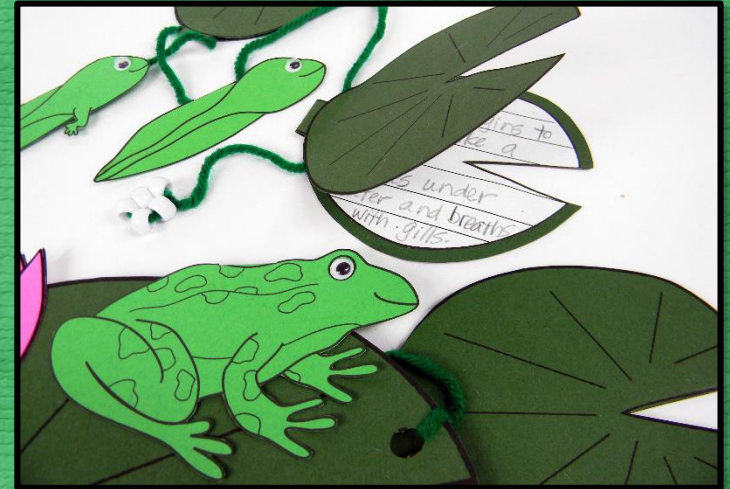
2 WRITE

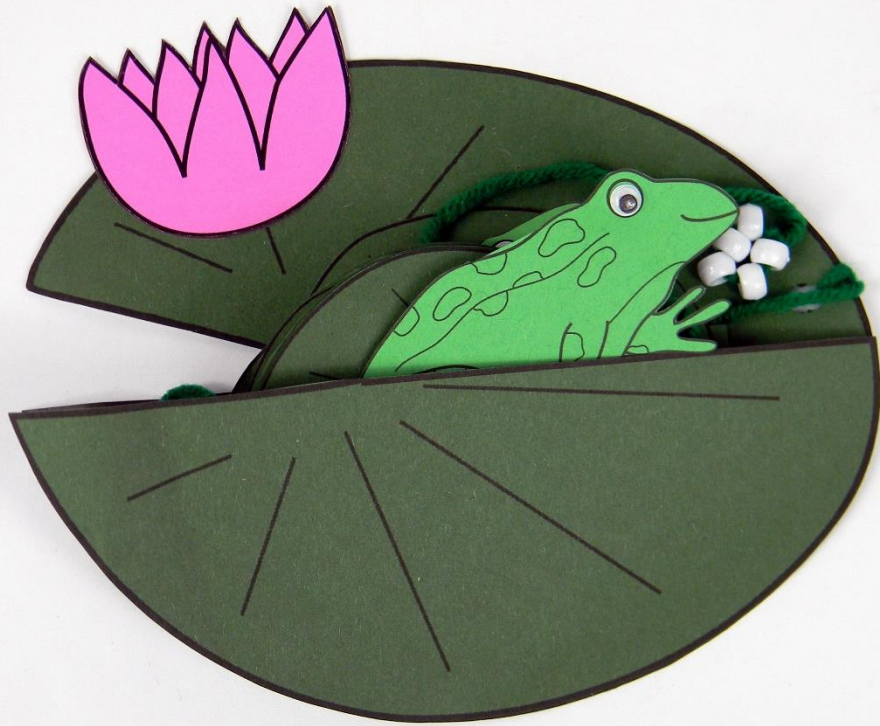
Add the mini books to the life cycle on a string craft

- 1 each of the following:



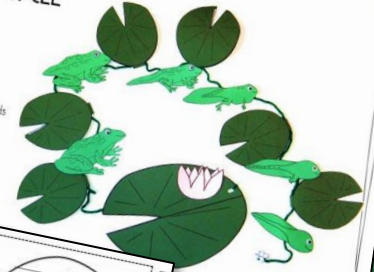
Lily Pad and Pocket

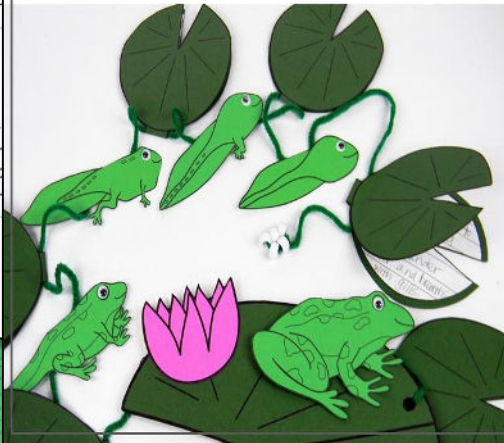
MATERIALS PER STUDENT:
