TRAVEL WITH A PASSPORT








Students add their photo to make a special passport before traveling to learn about their chosen country.





HOW TO USE THE SCRAPBOOK



I. LOGIN TO YOUR GOOGLE ACCOUNT

The download includes a PDF with step-bystep directions and a link page. When you click the link you will automatically be asked to make a copy of the file to save to your Drive. Open your Drive to see the copy inside the folder titled, Tpt Purchases.



2. CUSTOMIZE YOUR COVER Delete the existing text and type student or class name.

3. LEARN ABOUT THE COUNTRY Students click the flag on any slide to learn about the country.

4. TYPE ON THE SLIDES Students delete the existing text that says, "Type here", then type their own text.
