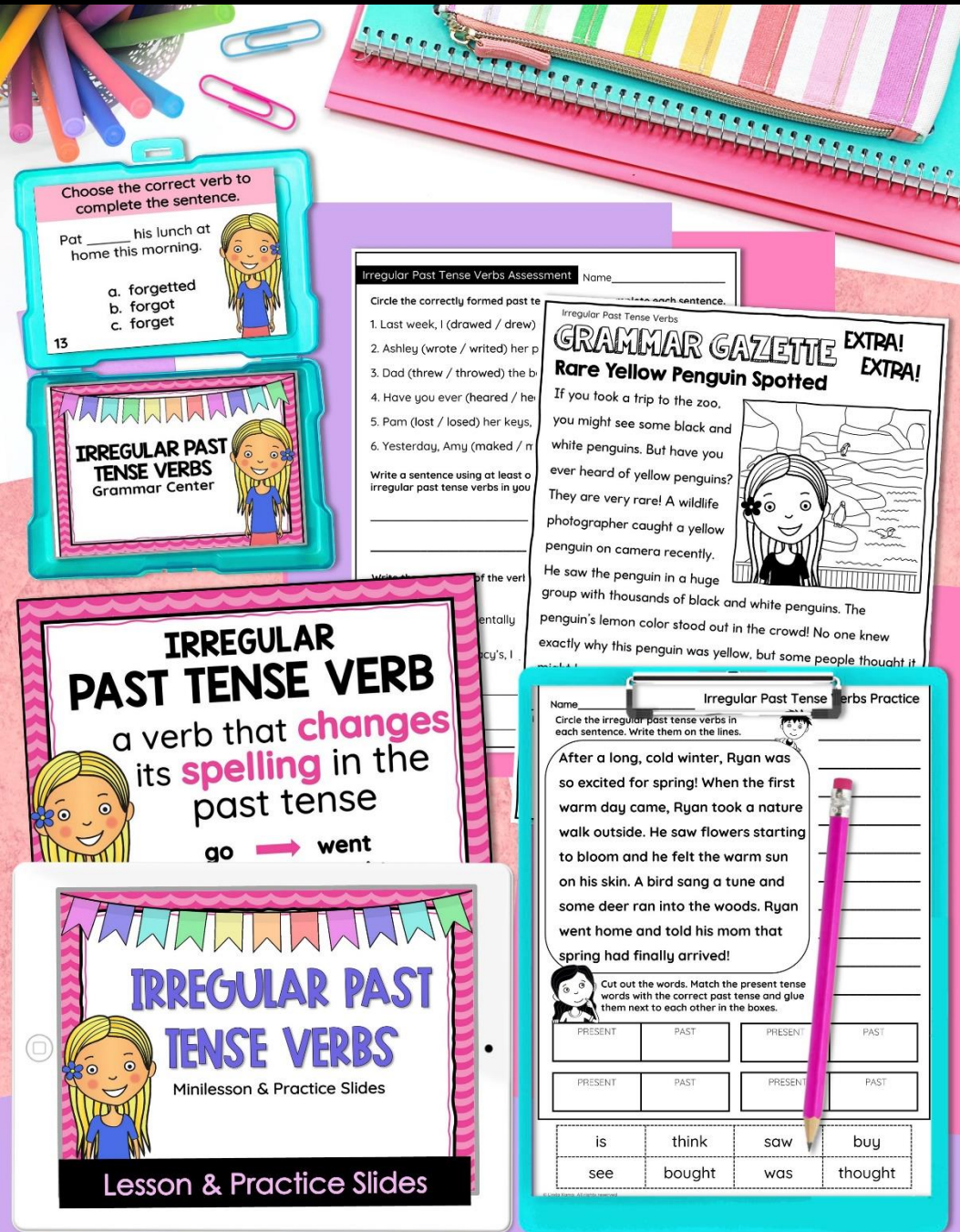

Monday

- Minilesson

*Each day's lesson & activity is designed to take 15 minutes.

1. Project the teaching PowerPoint. Introduce the weekly grammar skill. Read the lesson slides with students.
2. Follow the minilesson with whole group practice. For the first practice slide, up to 32 students can play. Call on a student to read the first word on the list and tell if it is an irregular past tense verb or not. The next student slides a check or X to the word. There is one other practice slide to help students practice forming irregular past tense verbs. This can be used to replace the first practice or in addition to the first practice. One of the practice activities can also be used on another day to help students review the skill.
3. Students work with a partner for the partner practice slide. Students use a journal, scrap paper, or whiteboards for the writing portion of the slide.

2. Students complete the practice worksheet.
