

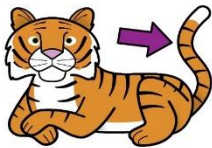

What is a vowel team?

A **vowel team** is a pair of vowels that appear next to each other in a word. They usually make the long sound of the first vowel.
