





#### **Teacher Directions**

Read the following directions aloud to students to guide them in completing their word ladders.

- 1. Say the picture name at the top of the ladder. Write the word. Let's spell the word together (CARD).
- 2. Change one letter to match the picture in the next line. What letter did you change? (D to T) What is the new word? Spell it. (CART).
- 3. Change one letter in cart to match the picture on the next line. What letter did you change? (C to D) What is the new word? Spell it. (DART)
- 4. Change one letter in dart to match the picture on the next line. What letter did you change? (T to K) What is the new word? Spell it. (DARK)
- 5. Change one letter in dark to match the picture on the next line. What letter did you change? (D to P) What is the new word? Spell it. (PARK)
- 6. Change one letter in park to match the picture on the next line. What letter did you change? (P to B) What is the new word? Spell it. (BARK)

#### **Teacher Directions**

Read the following directions aloud to students to guide them in completing their word ladders.

- 1. Say the picture name at the top of the ladder. Write the word. Let's spell the word together (SURF).
- 2. Change one letter to match the picture in the next line. What letter did you change? (S to T) What is the new word? Spell it. (TURF).
- Change one letter in turf to match the picture on the next line. What letter did you change? (F to N) What is the new word? Spell it. (TURN)
- 4. Change one letter in turn to match the picture on the next line. What letter did you change? (T to B) What is the new word? Spell it. (BURN)
- 5. Change one letter in burn to match the picture on the next line. What letter did you change? (N to P) What is the new word? Spell it. (BURP)
- 6. Change one letter in burp to match the picture on the next line. What letter did ....

A fun and easy way to practice phoneme substitution and build phonemic awareness




Supports decoding and encoding skills for reading and spelling practice



Words move in a progression that requires higher-level thinking




#### When to use Word Ladders






Or use the 1-picture prompt version for students to generate their own words!
