Read the following directions aloud to students to guide them in completing their word ladders.

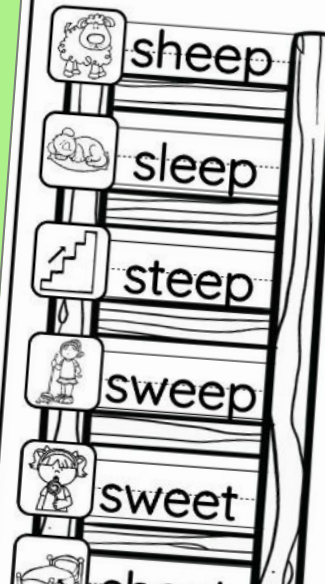
1. Say the picture name at the top of the ladder. Write the word. Let's spell the word together (RAY).
2. Change one letter to match the picture in the next line. What letter did you change? (R to H) What is the new word? Spell it. (HAY).
3. Change one letter in hay to match the picture on the next line. What letter did you change? (H to P) What is the new word? Spell it. (PAY)
4. Change one letter in pay to match the picture on the next line. What letter did you change? (P to B) What is the new word? Spell it. (BAY)
5. Change one letter in bay to match the picture on the next line. What letter did you change? (B to D) What is the new word? Spell it. (DAY)
6. Change one letter in day to match the picture on the next line. What letter did you change? (D to S) What is the new word? Spell it. (SAY)

### Teacher Directions

Read the following directions aloud to students to guide them in completing their word ladders.

1. Say the picture name at the top of the ladder. Write the word. Let's spell the word together (SHEEP).
2. Change one letter to match the picture in the next line. What letter did you change? (H to L) What is the new word? Spell it. (SLEEP).
3. Change one letter in sleep to match the picture on the next line. What letter did you change? (L to T) What is the new word? Spell it. (STEEP)
4. Change one letter in steep to match the picture on the next line. What letter did you change? (P to T) What is the new word? Spell it. (SWEEP)
5. Change one letter in sweep to match the picture on the next line. What letter did you change? (P to T) What is the new word? Spell it. (SWEET)
6. Change one letter in sweet to match the picture on the next line. What letter did you change? (T to S) What is the new word? Spell it. (SWEAT)

Words move in a progression that requires higher-level thinking

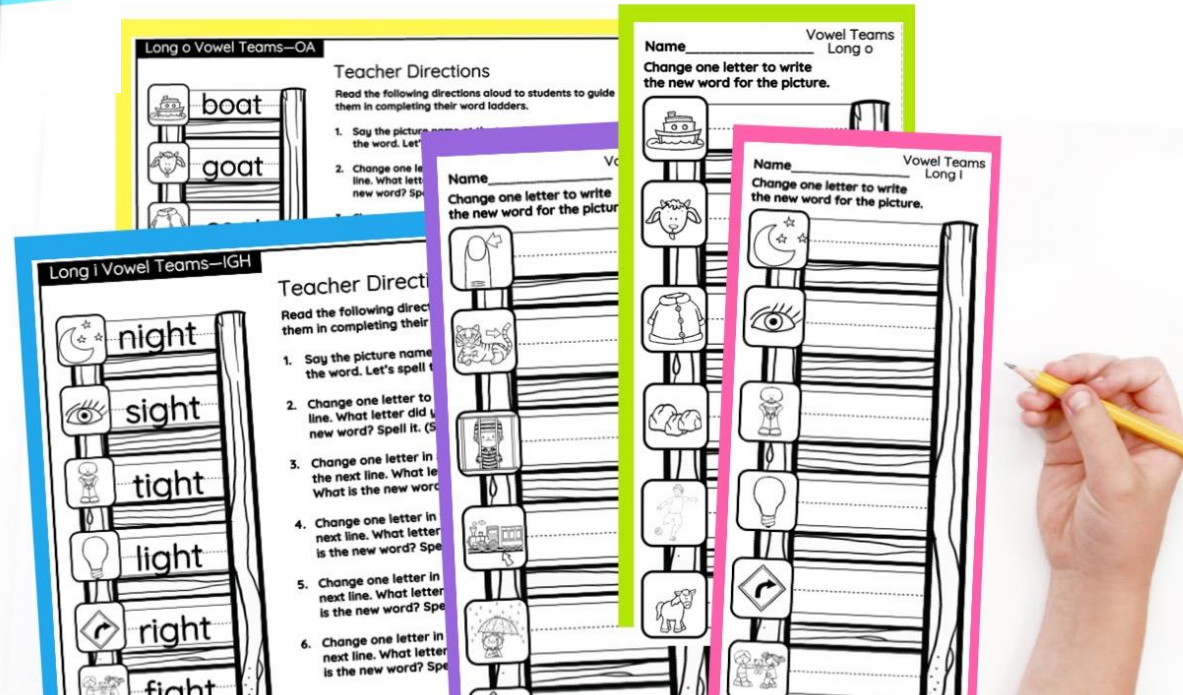


# When to use Word Ladders

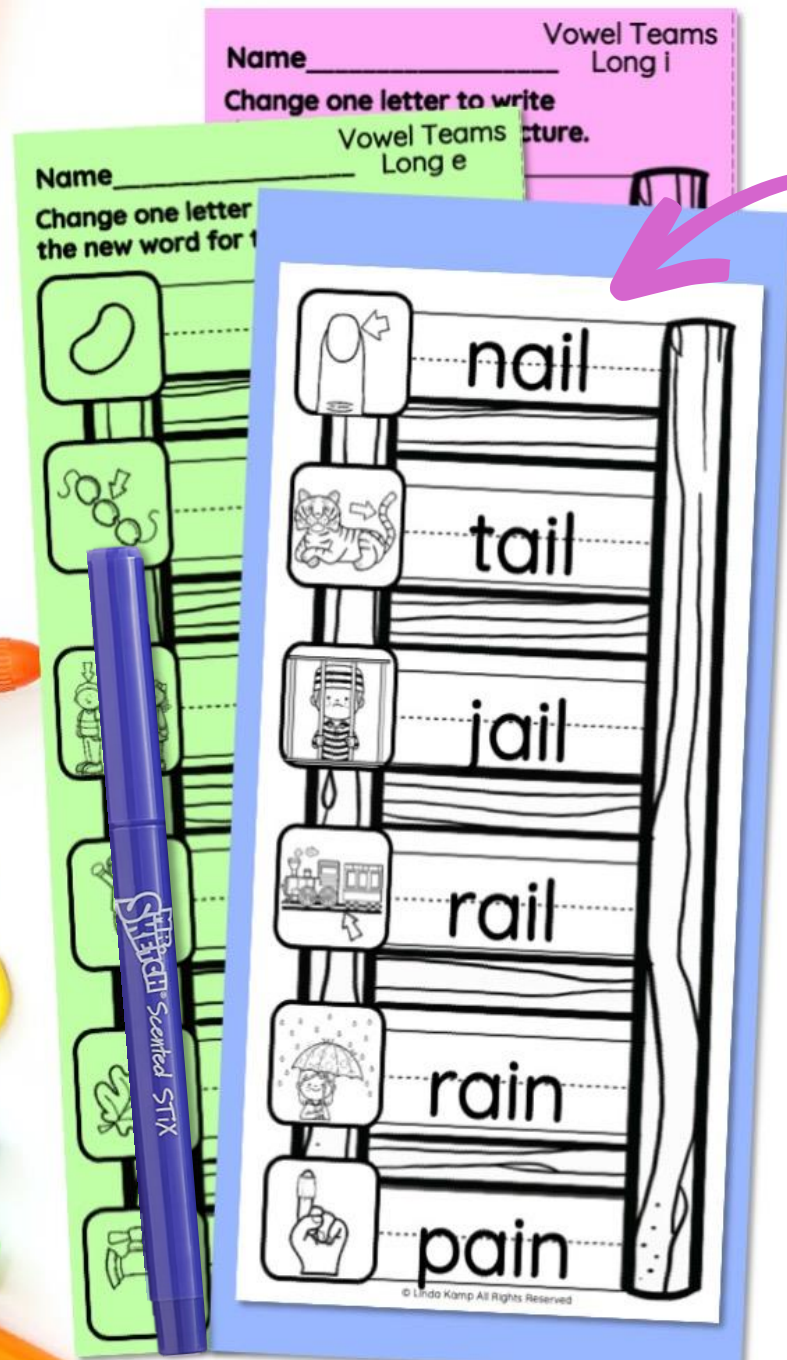


- ★ During phonics lessons as practice or review

## MAKE SELF-CHECKING PHONICS CENTERS!

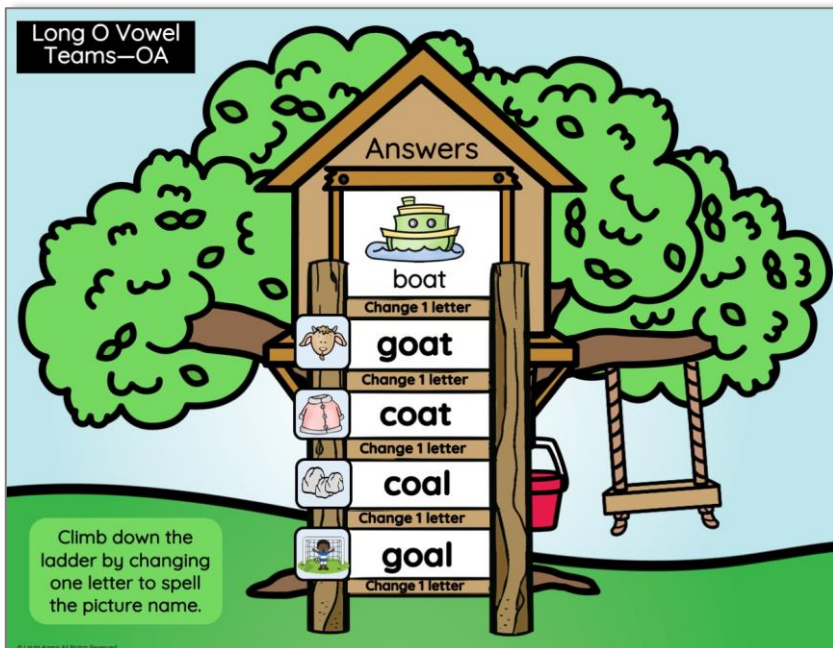
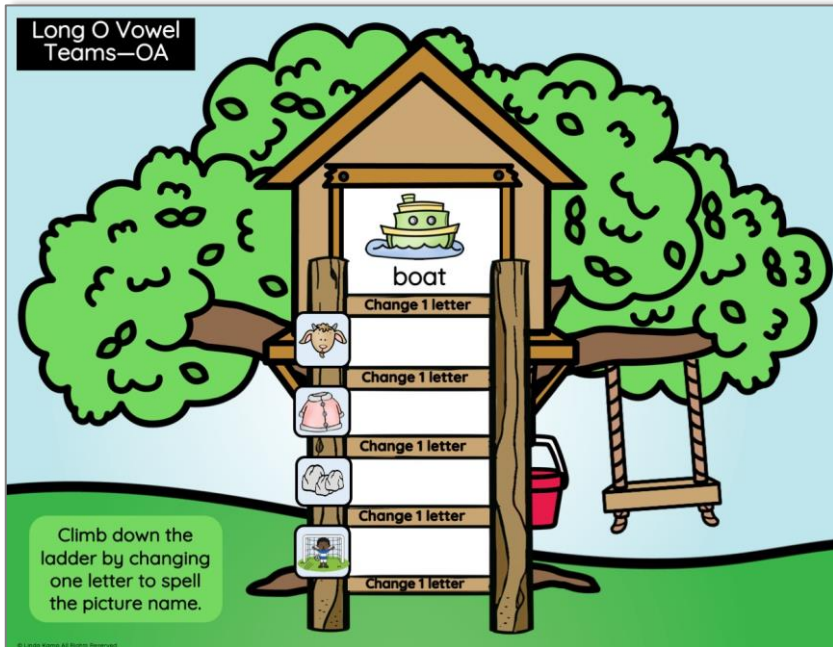
